







## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Thistle Colorway:

Fabric A	LMB-18732	2 yd.
Fabric B	LMB-18731	1 5/8 yd.
Fabric C	LMB-18729	1/4 yd.
Fabric E	LMB-18724	7/8 yd.
Fabric D	LMB-18725	3/8 yd.
Fabric F	LMB-18722	1/4 yd.

Oats Colorway:

Fabric A	LMB-28732	2 yd.
Fabric B	LMB-28731	1 5/8 yd.
Fabric C	LMB-28730	1/4 yd.
Fabric D	LMB-28723	3/8 yd.
Fabric E	LMB-28729	1 1/4 yd.
Fabric F	LMB-28726	1/4 yd.

### BACKING FABRIC

LMB-18730 4 1/4 yd. (*Thistle*)

LMB-28730 4 1/4 yd. (*Oats*)

### BINDING FABRIC

LMB-18729- (fabric C) included

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included.

All strips refer to cutting Width of Fabric

### From Fabric A:

- Cut Eight (8) 4 1/2" strips and sub-cut sixty-four (64) 4 1/2" squares
- Take eleven (11) squares from above and cut along the diagonal to make twenty-one (21) triangles for the sides of quilt. Set aside.
- Cut six (6) 5" strips. Sub-cut forty-eight (48) 5" squares for half square triangles.

### From Fabric B:

- Cut eleven (11) 4 1/2" strips and sub cut ninety-six (96) 4 1/2" squares
- Take eleven (11) squares from above and cut along the diagonal to make twenty-two (22) triangles for the sides of quilt
- Cut one (1) 5" square.

### From Fabric C:

- Cut one (1) 4 1/2" square and cut on the diagonal to make a triangle for side-setting
- Cut one (1) 5" strip and sub-cut six (6) 5" squares

### From Fabric D:

- Cut two (2) 5" strips and sub-cut ten (10) 5" squares.\*
- Cut one (1) 4 1/2" square and cut on the diagonal to make a triangle for side-setting

### From Fabric E:

- Cut five (5) 5" strips. Sub-cut thirty-seven (37) 5" squares.

### From Fabric F:

- Cut one (1) 5" strip and sub-cut five (5) 5" squares.

## CONSTRUCTION

*Sew all rights sides together with 1/4" seam allowance.*

### Making the Half Square Triangles (HST)

- On the wrong side of the lightest square from each pair, mark a diagonal line.
- Place each marked square right sides together with its mate and stitch 1/4" away on both sides of the line.
- Cut on the marked line and press the seam allowance open.
- Trim and square the HST units to 4 1/2". (A little extra fabric has been included for accuracy so they must all be trimmed to size.)
- This method makes two HST units at a time. (Diagram 1)
