





Fabric F	GLR44308	$\frac{3}{4}$ yd.
Fabric G	GLR44309	$\frac{3}{8}$ yd.
Fabric H	GLR44307	$\frac{3}{8}$ yd.
Fabric I	GLR44311	$\frac{1}{2}$ yd.
Fabric J	GLR44306	$\frac{5}{8}$ yd.
Fabric K	PE538	$\frac{5}{8}$ yd.

BACKING FABRIC

GLR44310 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ yds (Suggested)

BINDING FABRIC

Fabric **K** PE538 (Included)

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

$\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.

- Six (6) $9\frac{5}{8}$ " squares from fabric **A**.
- Six (6) $9\frac{5}{8}$ " squares from fabric **B**.
- Six (6) $9\frac{5}{8}$ " squares from fabric **C**.
- Six (6) $9\frac{5}{8}$ " squares from fabric **D**.
- Six (6) 1" squares from fabric **D**.
- Twenty-four (24) 2" squares from fabric **D**.

- Two (2) $18\frac{1}{4}$ " squares from fabric **E**.
- Two (2) $25\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from fabric **E**.
- Six (6) $7\frac{1}{8}$ " squares from fabric **E**.
- Twenty-four (24) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from fabric **F**.
- Twenty-four (24) 2" squares from fabric **F**.
- Twenty-four (24) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" rectangles from fabric **F**.
- Twenty-four (24) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1" strips from fabric **F**.
- Twenty-four (24) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from fabric **G**.
- Twenty-four (24) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from fabric **H**.
- Six (6) $7\frac{1}{8}$ " squares from fabric **I**.
- Twelve (12) $7\frac{1}{8}$ " squares from fabric **J**.
- Eight (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips from fabric **K**. (Binding)

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

- Place one (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " square from fabrics **F** & **H** right sides of fabrics together.
- Use a fabric marker to trace a diagonal line.
- Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the line.
- Use your rotary cutter and clear ruler to cut on top of the drawn line.
- Press open and you'll end up with two **FH** HST's. Trim each piece to a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
- Make a total of twenty four (24) **FH** HST's.




DIAGRAM 1

- Repeat the same steps with twelve (12) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from fabric **F** and **G** to get a total of twenty four (24) **FG** and twelve (12) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from fabric **G** and **H** to get a total of twenty four (24) **GH**. See diagram 2 for reference.

- Attach the rows together.
- Press.




DIAGRAM 9

- Take one (1) $9\frac{5}{8}$ " square from fabric **A** & **B**.
- Use your rotary cutter to cut diagonally across the squares and end up with two (2) half square triangles from each fabric.
- Attach the **A** half square triangles to the left and right sides of the previous made block.



DIAGRAM 10

- Then, attach the **B** half square triangles to the top and bottom sides of the previous made block.
- Press and set aside.
- Make a total of six (6) block #1.




DIAGRAM 11

BLOCK #2:

- Bring two (2) **IJ** & **EJ** HST's.
- Attach one (1) **IJ** to one (1) **EJ** and then one **EJ** to one (1) **IJ** as shown in the diagram below.
- Attach the rows together.
- Press.




DIAGRAM 12

- Take one (1) $9\frac{5}{8}$ " square from fabric **C** & **D**.
- Use your rotary cutter to cut diagonally across the squares and end up with two (2) half square triangles from each fabric.
- Attach the **D** half square triangles to the left and right sides of the previously made block.




DIAGRAM 13

- Then, attach the **C** half square triangles to the top and bottom sides of the previously made block.
- Press and set aside.
- Make a total of six (6) block #2.


